Perfect your profession, you are the home of the world, don't die, don't be sad. I don't want to go through the world incompletely, it's necessary to come out of the bathroom unclean[3].

In our opinion, these immortal thoughts of Hazrat Navoiyi will be the answer to our following questions.

- **2. Methods.** The "4 k" model has entered the updated educational system of Uzbekistan.
- "1k" Critical thinking (kritichiskoe mishlenie);
- "2k" creative thinking (kreativnoe mishlenie);
- "3 k" collaboration, that is, working with a team (kollektivnoe zaniyatie)
- "4 k" communicativeness communication.

Students are asked the following questions:

- 1. What does a person benefit others with?
- 2. What is the purpose of human life?

We will connect the first verses quoted above by Hazrat Navoiyi with the science of education, focusing on integration education. We know that not only knowledge is imparted in education, but students are actively prepared for social life. That is, students are taught not to give opinions, but to think.

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Where is the integration? The poet makes extensive comments about this. It encourages students to pay attention to the nature of the positive changes that are taking place and engage them not with empty talk, but with practical work. This is how he refers to a person who bears the name "human". That is, every person who comes into the world should be inculcated with the feelings of belonging to the homeland. First of all, it is necessary for our youth to learn in-depth knowledge in all aspects, to be a skilled master of their profession, to love their motherland, and to have qualities such as glorifying national traditions and values. Otherwise, as Hazrat Navoiy said, it is as if he entered the bathroom without washing and leaving without purification. This idea put forward by students is a clear example of critical thinking (in the example of "1k").

In order to engage students in creative thinking, the following question is asked. If you were to fall into the era of Alisher Navoiy, what would you bring from there (in the example of "2 k"). As experts, we know that "Tarbiya" textbooks are based on the wise words of our grandfather, the enlightened writer Abdulla Avloni (1878-1934).

For example:

A child that can't be had by giving birth is a future disaster

If his body is trained, he will be able to do it

A scientist becomes the bane of a blacksmith if he gets an education

If his morals are broken, his son is a tyrant[2].

(From the work of Turkish Gulistan or Akhlaq).

This is an example of "3k", whose students are directed to work with a team. Not all students have developed speaking skills. Even if some students know, they cannot express their opinion freely and independently. Working in a team creates an environment of healthy competition and allows students to speak freely.

It forms the ability of students to listen to each other, respect their opinions, and engage in dialogue based on healthy competition. This can be an example of "4 k". That is, it can be an example of openness to communication.

**Result:** through the study of topics included in the subject of motherhood and education in middle and upper classes, students will acquire critical thinking, be able to cooperate in a team, follow responsibilities and obligations, develop physical and intellectual confidence, and take an active citizenship position. is taught to be able to occupy, to feel social existence and to enjoy it. As a result of teaching the above-mentioned "4k" model to the graduates in the classrooms, they will be able to cooperate with the work team and specialists, systematize the regular improvement of their knowledge and have an active citizenship position, be able to critically evaluate their actions, and be involved in the fate of the country. having high spiritual and moral qualities, as well as being able to promote them, they will have BKM and competencies.

**Discussion:** if the strict demand for education and its quality in general secondary schools is made a constant need by the school management, students and their parents, the teacher who regularly works on himself will be adequately encouraged. on the contrary, if an atmosphere of intolerance is formed towards teachers who do not pay attention to their own development, the teacher will have a desire to work on himself regularly, that is, to acquire knowledge and skills.
