If we analyze the concept of facilitator based on the sources, this concept was introduced into science by classical psychologist Carl Rogers. The English word "facilitate" means "to ease, to cooperate". So, the main task of the teacher is to facilitate and at the same time stimulate the educational activity, i.e. to create the necessary intellectual and emotional environment and psychological support in the group.

Facilitation in the school education system is aimed at creating a comfortable environment in the room that ensures a positive impact on students, increasing students' confidence in their own strength, encouraging the need for independent work and should be understood as a method of developmental education in the way of support. Facilitation activities can be used in the school system in both primary and upper grades. But the importance of this process used in primary classes is several times higher than in upper classes. Because through this process, the children's interest in the lesson increases several times, which helps them to achieve a high level of education. The person who creates the facilitation process and manages it is called a facilitator.

In the field of education, this place belongs to the teacher. His task is not to show himself as a governor, but to take a neutral position and guide students to study knowledge with sufficient accuracy and in the right direction of development. The activity of a pedagogue-facilitator has a beneficial effect on the development of initiative and independence of students, forms communicative interaction skills, and helps to create a comfortable environment for communication between students during the educational process. is a person who helps to create an environment. In this case, the educational process is characterized by the use of methods and technologies that save freedom and health.

A teacher-facilitator is a person-centered approach to education and an empathetic caregiver of students' feelings, inner experiences, abilities and potential, activities and actions, encouraging their success and service. , a teacher with a confident attitude. Facilitator is a special tool in the educational process. 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


Figure 1. Facilitator characteristics
